City Budget Presentation and Q&A

Easthampton, MA - The City of Easthampton is committed to open, transparent government and meaningful community engagement. As part of that commitment, the city is hosting two upcoming public events to give residents the opportunity to learn about, ask questions about, and provide input on the proposed municipal budget. All Easthampton residents are encouraged to attend and participate. No prior knowledge of city finances is required; these sessions are designed to be accessible and informative for everyone.

EVENT 1: Budget Q&A Session

EVENT 2: Community Budget Forum

Date: Monday, June 2, 2026 @ 6pm

Location: Easthampton High School

The Q&A session will offer residents an opportunity to ask questions about the city's proposed budget. City officials and department heads will be on hand to address resident questions, explain budget priorities, and discuss how funds are allocated across city departments and services. The Community Budget Forum will provide a broader overview of the city's fiscal year budget proposal, including key investments, anticipated challenges, and long-term financial planning. This forum will feature a presentation by city leadership followed by an open discussion period, giving residents the chance to share feedback and ask questions in a community setting.
